WESTconsin Credit Union has been serving members since 1939, and membership is open to anyone who lives or works in the Wisconsin counties of Barron, Buffalo, Burnett, Chippewa, Clark, Dunn, Eau Claire, Jackson, Pepin, Pierce, Polk, Rusk, St. Croix, Sawyer, Taylor, Trempealeau, and Washburn, or the Minnesota counties of Anoka, Chisago, Dakota, Goodhue, Hennepin, Isanti, Pine, Ramsey, Scott, Wabasha, and Washington, with a \$5 minimum deposit in a Membership Savings Account. Credit unions are financial institutions owned by their accountholders, and member funds are federally insured by the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) up to at least \$250,000.

- 1. **Determine your income**: Calculate all the money you receive each month from your job, side hustles, investments, and other sources.

- 3. Categorize your expenses: Categorize your expenses into fixed costs (such as rent and utilities) and variable costs (such as entertainment and dining out).
- 4. **Prioritize your expenses**: Determine which costs are essential and which ones you can live without. Prioritize necessary expenses and look for ways to reduce or eliminate non-essential expenses.
- 5. **Set financial goals**: Identify your short-term and long-term goals, such as saving for a down payment on a house or paying off credit card debt.
- 6. Allocate your income: Allocate your money to cover your expenses and achieve your financial goals. Make sure to include savings and investments in your budget.
- 7. Monitor your budget: Monitor your spending regularly to ensure you stick to it and adjust as

necessary.
