DEAR HORSE OWNER.

YOU AND YOUR HORSES ARE CORDIALLY INVITED TO BE PART OF THE 35TH ANNUAL BALDWIN WOODVILLE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE'S CHRISTMAS SPIRIT HORSE & WAGON PARADE ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 7, 2024, IN BALDWIN, WI. THE PARADE WILL ONCE AGAIN BE COMBINED WITH SANTA'S & MRS. CLAUS' VISIT TO THE PILLAR BANK.

WE PLAN TO RETURN TO OUR PREVIOUS LOCATION AT STRIKER'S LANES AND LOUNGE FOR OUR PARADE LINE-UP. THIS WILL GIVE YOU A LOCATION WHERE YOU WILL BE ABLE TO WARM UP BEFORE AND AFTER THE PARADE. YOU WILL BE PARKING BEHIND THE BOWLING ALLEY AND ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF 8TH AVENUE. WE WILL ALSO USE THE CEMETARY FOR ADDITIONAL PARKING AND LINEUP SPACE AS NEEDED AS TO NOT OBSTRUE TRAFFIC. PARADE LINE UP LOCATION SUBJECT TO CHANGE, YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED PRIOR TO THE EVENT OF ALL THE FINAL DETAILS. PLEASE PROVIDE A COPY OF YOUR NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST REPORT FOR US TO KEEP ON FILE. WHEN YOU CHECK IN, YOU WILL RECEIVE YOUR LINE UP NUMBER AND A MAP.

PLEASE PLAN TO ARRIVE AT STRIKER'S BETWEEN 10:45/11:15 AM. HORSES NEED TO BE UNLOADED, LINED-UP AND READY TO LEAVE STRIKER'S AT 11:45 AM SHARP!

SINCE ONE OF THE HIGHLIGHTS FOR THIS EVENT EACH YEAR IS THAT THE RESIDENTS AT THE BALDWIN CARE CENTER CAN ENJOY THE PARADE, WE WILL CONTINUE THE TRADITION AGAIN THIS YEAR BY RIDING AROUND THE FACILITY.

THE PARADE WILL REACH MAIN STREET AT 12:15PM AND PROCEED DOWN MAIN STREET AND THEN RETURN TO STRIKER'S. PARADE UNITS WILL BE JUDGED ON HOLIDAY SPIRIT, OVERALL PRESENTATION, AND CREATIVITY. SCEDC - 2024 Business of the Year Nominations

Dear community.

As we look to celebrate excellence in our community, we are reaching out to gather nominations for the 2024 Business of the Year Award. This award recognizes three outstanding businesses that have made a significant impact in St. Croix County.

One award from each category will be given:

- *Emerging Business of the Year company that has been in business less than five years and headquartered in St. Croix County.
- *Small Business of the Year company with 29 or fewer employees and must be located in St. Croix County for at least 5 years.
- *Large Business of the Year company with 30 or more employees and must be located in St. Croix County for at least 5 years.

Eligible Businesses

Qualifying companies must be involved in manufacturing, distribution, construction, health care, or must be a service provider to other companies. Companies must operate for profit. (Retail and non-profit companies are not eligible.) Self-nominations are expected and encouraged. For more information on eligibility, please check the Nomination Guidelines form.

Kindly ensure your nominations are <u>submitted</u> by Friday, December 13th.
