Giving Back to our Community



Thanks to the success of our Annual Golf Tournament and raffles at the Annual Dinner Meeting we've been able to give back to our community in big ways.

First, we were able to help support Carol (Stitchin' Post) and Brian (B2B Sealcoating) Smith as on August 14th, Brian had a serious accident at the Brainerd races, resulting in a fractured skull and traumatic brain injury, requiring helicopter transport to North Memorial hospital. After surgery to relieve swelling, he was discharged on August 29th but had to return on September 4th due to complications, including drainage issues and speech difficulties. Another surgery was performed to address infection. Despite setbacks, including a seizure and fluid buildup, his recovery progressed with physical, occupational, and speech therapy. Doctors are optimistic about his release on September 20th. After nearly 7 weeks, they feel hopeful as Brian received positive news from his Infectious Disease doctor. He no longer needs the IV Vancomycin antibiotics and is now on oral antibiotics twice daily, allowing for the removal of his PICC line. Additionally, he has been cleared to replace his skull flap *hopefully* within the next two weeks, involving a quick surgery and a short hospital stay of 2-3 days.

Next, we were able to support the Central St Croix Love Basket Program. Last year, they provided baskets to 89 families, and 20 fruit baskets. They are expected to deliver more than 90 this year.
