Recipients were selected based on a variety of criteria including community and school involvement, academic progress, financial need, career plans, and goals.

David Thompson, a Baldwin-Woodville High School graduate, was the chosen scholarship recipient from the Baldwin area. Thompson will use the money to help fund his post-secondary education plans at University of Wisconsin-Stout to study Mechanical Engineering, Plastics Engineering, and Applied Physics.
