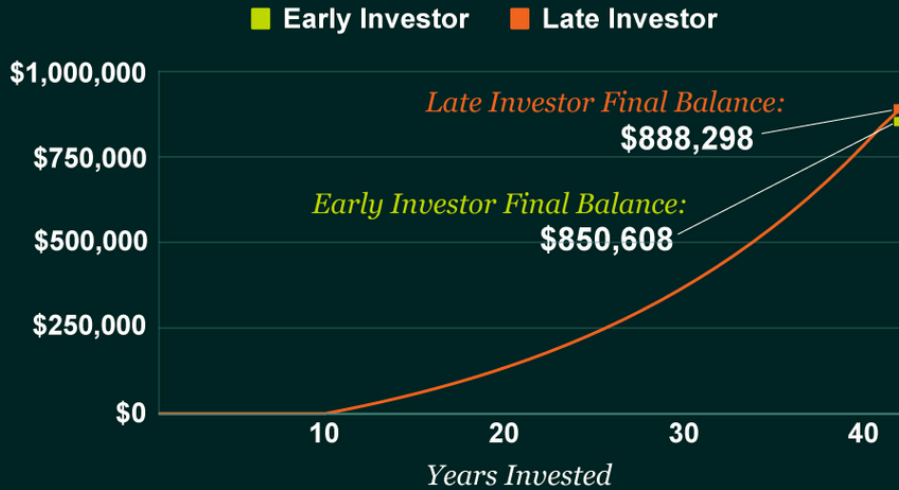
The early investor put in \$100,000.
